PERSONAL EFFECTS INVENTORY

As a result of the loss of personal effects while in foster care due to nondefinable and unexplicable circumstances, it is highly advisable that foster youth do not enter foster care with extensive personal effects. C.C.R. discourages the possession of expensive electronics, jewelry, C.D.'s, computer games and other items that are targets of theft and have street market value for cash and barter.

Community Care Resources, Inc. will not inventory, maintain, control, supervise or account for foster youth personal effects other than **clothing only**. Community Care Resources disclaims any and all responsibility for the losses of any and all personal effects that a foster youth might incur while in care. Personal effects are the sole responsibility of the foster youth and biological parent.

Any and all contraband items such as cigarettes, tobacco products, weapons and pornography should not accompany the foster youth. Possession of same will result in immediate confiscation without compensation.
